

**FACTS****WHAT DO FIRST NATIONAL BANK & TRUST, BANK OF POCAHONTAS, & INTEGRITY FIRST BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

**What?**

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- credit history and transaction or loss history
- assets and employment information

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

**How?**

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons First National Bank & Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, & Integrity First Bank choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## What we do

<p><b>How do First National Bank &amp; Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, &amp; Integrity First Bank protect my personal information?</b></p>	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>In order to prevent unauthorized access to your information, we maintain security standards and procedures that conform with industry practices. These security standards and procedures are routinely tested to verify the integrity of our systems.</p>
<p><b>How do First National Bank &amp; Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, &amp; Integrity First Bank collect my personal information?</b></p>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ open an account or apply for a loan</li> <li>■ give us your income information or give us your employment history</li> <li>■ give us your contact information</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
<p><b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b></p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>■ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

## Definitions

<p><b>Affiliates</b></p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>First National Bank &amp; Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, &amp; Integrity First Bank have no affiliates.</i></li> </ul>
<p><b>Nonaffiliates</b></p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>First National Bank &amp; Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, &amp; Integrity First Bank do not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>
<p><b>Joint Marketing</b></p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <i>First National Bank &amp; Trust, Bank of Pocahontas, &amp; Integrity First Bank don't jointly market.</i></li> </ul>
